- 7. If more than one of the joint holders be present at the EGM personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the register in respect of the relevant shares shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.

To be valid, this form of proxy, together with the power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a certified copy of that power or authority, must be deposited at the Company's Hong Kong branch share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited (the "Branch Share Registrar") at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, not less than 48 hours before the time for holding the EGM or adjourned meeting (as the case may be).
- 9. Completion and delivery of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the EGM should you so wish. In such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- 10. Any alteration made in this form of proxy must be initialed by the person who signs it.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT
